Workshop description:

Managing livestock in dry times can be challenging, particularly when large areas of the farm have been affected. The loss of feed requires more intensive farming practices until pastures have reestablished and the soil is able to withstand livestock without causing erosion or pugging. There is also a higher risk of weed infestation with imported feed.
